


Prehistoric Archeology

This map was created using local GIS data and prehistoric archeological data from the Maine Historic Preservation Commission dated October 2006.

The yellow-coded "Areas of Prehistoric Sensitivity" are the areas most likely to contain prehistoric archeological remains.

The red-coded squares called "Prehistoric Resource Location - Masked" show generalized locations for known prehistoric resource sites. Each square is 500 meters across, and is randomly placed over the site to mask its actual location. There are 20 sites identified in York.
