**Topics Discussed:**

- 1) Minutes of the May 18, 2016 meeting were approved following edits. Dave will provide a copy of the minutes for posting on the Town Web site.
- 2) The committee continued to review the inputs received for the May 7<sup>th</sup> public forum on cycling and walking in York. Some of the themes that emerged from the forum and discussions with voters at the polling station:
  - The forum attendees focused on the Village, schools, and Beach areas.
  - Connector roads including Ridge, Woodbridge, and York Street were frequently mentioned.
  - Speed limits and enforcement of them was a major theme. Questions were raised about the logic used for varying speed limits on Route 1 and Woodbridge in particular.
  - Questions relating to “Complete Streets” – streets designed for all users – came up under topical areas of shoulders, roads, sidewalks, crosswalks, speed limits, street lights, and signage.
  - Incomplete sidewalks (e.g. along the west side of Route 1 from York Corners to the neighborhoods behind the new York Hospital Walk-in center and lack of sidewalks or paths from York Corners to Anthony’s) were brought up. It was also noted the sidewalks often switched from one side to the other.

Review of community inputs will continue at future meetings.

- 3) The Committee agreed that hard copy surveys would be collected from the Library, Senior Center, and Town Hall and that the Survey Link on the Town website would be removed by June 6<sup>th</sup>. Community members will continue to be encouraged to provide their suggestions for the Master Plan via email [bikepedyork@gmail.com](mailto:bikepedyork@gmail.com) or on the York Maine Bicycle and Pedestrian Facebook page.

**Action Items:**

Scott will continue work on summarizing public forum data and compiling survey data.

Committee members will review the Master Plans from Portsmouth, Bath, and Brunswick with emphasis on how they organized their plans and how they prioritized their recommendations for infrastructure and non-infrastructure changes.
