Illicit Discharge Detection & Elimination:

The Sewer District had three I/I incidents this month which were related to heavy rainfall on December 10th. I received a follow-up email from Tim Haskell, Sewer District Superintendent regarding each site stating: "All areas of release have been cleaned at this time and there is no visible impact to the areas."

Construction Site Stormwater Runoff Control:

At the Community Development Staff Meeting on December 3rd, I asked that CEO's be aware of all construction site entrances when doing an inspection or driving by a site.

Construction entrances are to be stabilized so that no sediment is tracked onto the road. I will bring this issue up periodically at our staff meetings.

There are currently no projects with soil disturbance greater than 1 acre.
