On Monday April 20<sup>th</sup>, Kristie and I will check on crews and answer any questions they may have about the form.

Mike Tibbetts and Steve Goodwin, York Sewer District, and myself performed dye testing of the boiler drains at the four schools. Testing was over a two day period, April 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>. This was done as part of the Operating and Maintenance Procedures to determine if an oil spill were to occur, what system these drains would discharge into. A written report, along with maps of each school is included in the O&M Procedures binder in my office.
