


# Historic Archeology

This map was created using local GIS data and historic archeological data from the Maine Historic Preservation Commission dated October 2006.

The yellow-coded "Areas of Historic Sensitivity" are the areas most likely to contain archeological remains from early historic occupation.

The red-coded squares called "Known Location - Masked" show generalized locations for known historic resource sites. Each square is 500 meters across, and is randomly placed over the site to mask its actual location. There are known locations for only 146 of 199 resources identified in York.
