Public Education & Outreach on Stormwater Impacts:

None scheduled for August.

Public Involvement & Participation:

Hazardous Waste Day is October 26th at the Transfer Station, registration is required. Contact Public Works at 363-1010 to register.

Illicit Discharge Detection & Elimination:

Data from the Bacteria Tracking Dog event showed high bacteria counts at the outfall on Long Sands near Beacon Street containing high levels of bacteria. Letter sent to Udell Park Homeowners Association for advanced stormwater system maintenance records as the first step in investigation. High levels were also found in the Town owned wetland off Wananque Road. (Pieces of toilet paper and "sanitary fungus".) This wetland drains onto Cape Neddick Beach. Letters went out to 6 property owners requesting permission to perform dye testing, property inspections and sewer pipe inspections.

Brett has been updating the catch basin inspection program for the iPad. He has also labeled all the catch basins using EPA's labeling system. He and I walked Long Sands Beach mapping the outfalls. Brett will give refresher training on the iPad catch basin app in September to the Public Works crew and me.

Construction Site Stormwater Runoff Control:

There are currently no projects with soil disturbance greater than 1 acre.

The Code Enforcement currently requires erosion and sediment control measures in the shoreland overlay zone. This will be expanded town wide no later than June 30, 2015.
