Hi LeeJay and Steve,

Further to the sketch plan review meeting last Thursday, I thought it would be beneficial to schedule a meeting regarding what we will need to submit to meet the preliminary review criteria with regards to traffic.

This is an unusual project as it will not generate any significant traffic per se. The new police station is designed to serve existing staff (with some allowance for future growth), all of whom are currently located in the nearby facility. The new Connector Road will not be a traffic *generator*, but will attract traffic that currently uses other routes to get to and from the beach.

~~We had approached this in the previous application by providing concise letter reports summarizing pertinent traffic information related to the project, but it would be valuable for us to review our approach with you and your traffic engineer prior to submission to ensure that our approach will be acceptable.
