- Board of Assessment Review (2 Regular Member Vacancies)
Review of assessments upon complaint of property owners. Meetings are held as needed.
- Cable TV Regulatory Board (1 Regular Member Vacancy)
Exercise continuing regulatory jurisdiction and supervision over the construction and operation of the cable television system installed with representatives from North Berwick, Wells and Ogunquit. Meetings are held as needed.
- Cliff Walk Committee (1 Regular Member Vacancy)
Pursue the interests of the Town and its citizens, in keeping the Cliff Walk open for use by the public and ensuring that the walk is safe and property maintained. Meetings are held on the second Monday - 5:30PM.
- Conservation Commission (1 Alternate Member Vacancy)
Advisors to the Selectmen regarding the protection of natural resources through education and awareness of the environment. Meetings are held on the second Tuesday - 7:00PM.
- Harbor Board (1 Alternate Member Vacancy)
Overseeing and planning the general operation of the Harbors and tidal waters in town. Meetings are held on the first Wednesday - 7:00PM.
- Historic District Commission (3 District Representatives for Lindsay Road, the Village and the Harbor districts)
Assist, advise and educate owner of historic structures, buildings or site on physical aspects of preservation, renovation and rehabilitation with the application process for Certificates of Appropriateness and Certificates of Demolition. Meetings are held the first Wednesday - 5:30PM.
- Multi-Generational Community Center Needs Assessment Committee (2 Regular Member Vacancies)
Conducting a multi-generational community center needs assessment. Meeting schedule has not been established yet.
- Municipal Social Services Review Board (1 Regular Member Vacancy)
Review requests for Social Service Agency Funding and present recommendations to the Selectmen for their review. Meetings are held as needed.

- Senior Citizens Advisory Board (1 Regular Member Vacancy)
Manage, supervise and direct the operations of the York Senior Center in conjunction with the Senior Center Coordinator. Meetings are held on the third Tuesday - 12:45PM.
- Shellfish Conservation Commission (3 Regular Member Vacancies)
Administer the Shellfish Conservation Program in the town. Meetings are held as needed.
- Village Revitalization Steering Committee (3 Regular Member Vacancies)
Advise the Selectmen on matters related to the Village Revitalization infrastructure projected based upon the York Village Master Plan. Also, assist the Public Works Director on various matters required to complete the project and coordinate activities related to the community and direct-stakeholder outreach. Meeting schedule has not been established yet.
- York Harbor Site Design Review Board (2 Regular Member Vacancies)
Authorize variances from the site development requirements, off-street parking and supplemental provisions of the Zoning Ordinance. Meetings are held as needed.
- York Housing Authority (1 Regular Member Vacancy)
By State Law, undertake and carry out studies and analyses of the housing needs within its area of operations. Meetings are held the second Wednesday - 9:00AM)
