MS4 Permit Requirements and Meetings for September:

- York County MS4 Group: Group met September 18th at the Kittery Town Hall. Meeting focus was Targeted Behavior Change. Members from the Cape Neddick River Association and Conservation Commission chair were invited.
- Meeting at Public Works Facility with Dean Lessard, Tim DePerrio, Liz Hayden, and Steve Burns to discuss MS4 budget and account spending. It was decided that Liz and Leslie will communicate and expenses each department incurs.
- Brett and I met with Kristie Rabasca, MS4 Consultant, about identifying catch basins, outfalls, and ditches.

MS4 MINIMUM CONTROL MEASURES:

Public Education & Outreach on Stormwater Impacts:

None scheduled for September.

Public Involvement & Participation:

Hazardous Waste Day is October 26th at the Transfer Station, registration is required. Contact Public Works at 363-1010 to register.

Illicit Discharge Detection & Elimination:

Letters were sent to 6 property owners located above the Town owned wetland requesting permission to perform a dye test, inspect the home sewer pipe and inspect the grounds. Five of the 6 property owners were very cooperative in allowing the Town to conduct the dye test and inspections. Property owner at 15 Algonac Avenue is the only holdout. I will seek an Administrative Warrant to conduct the dye test and inspection.

On September 19, 2013, dye testing and inspections were conducted at 19, 29, & 43 Agamenticus Avenue. The 2 remaining properties were unavailable until after September 25th for testing.

Report received from Udell Park Homeowners Association on their advanced stormwater treatment system.

Construction Site Stormwater Runoff Control:

There are currently no projects with soil disturbance greater than 1 acre.

Post-construction Stormwater Management (New and Redevelopment):

I am currently working on erosion and sediment control measures ordinance for May 2014.
