

## **Meeting Minutes - York Conservation Commission**

**Date: September 11, 2012**

**Attending: Dave Tibbetts, Ana Gray, Bob Tilley, Jeff Normandin**

- 1- Minutes from August 14 meeting were accepted unanimously.
- 2- Mike Mahlman has now been appointed a full commission member, Jeff Normandin's appointment is still pending.
- 3- The site walk notice for the new Jellison Subdivision was not sent to all members in a timely manner. It would be helpful if future site walks could be held after 4 pm. We need to request plans and access to the properties on all such development projects. We need to follow-up on our past requests to the planning board on the process and proposed regulation changes.
- 4- Lawns to Lobsters with Linda Scotland Mainely Grass Presentation were reviewed. Bob talked about fiscal responsibility with costs of the L2L subcommittee. Our commission will help write grant requests for the L2L.
- 5- Jeff discussed the Kittery proposal for a new septic pumping regulation. York regulations are now every 3 years within the shoreline district and 5 years outside the district.
- 6- The new web page should be ready in October.
- 7- The police station project has run into problems due to the contractor and engineers not following the plans. We will discuss in more detail at our next meeting.
