Mr. Marshall, filling in for the absent Chair, convened the meeting at a break in a joint meeting with the Board of Selectmen. The time was approximately 9:25 PM. The Chair appointed Mr. Remick to sit in place of Mr. Macdonald, and appointed Mr. Estes to sit in place of Mr. Farrell.

The following motion was made by Mr. Munro and seconded by Mr. Estes: the Planning Board recommends approval of Zoning Draft 10B and recommends that the Board of Selectmen place Zoning Draft 10B on the warrant for the November General Referendum. Discussion ensued. Mr. Munro noted the diligent 20 month process, the significant amount of public involvement in the process, and that this zoning amendment will bring the Zoning Ordinance closer to compliance with the Comprehensive Plan than would otherwise possible. Mr. Estes agreed with Mr. Munro, that the draft was developed with extensive public input, that like any document it will require further work over time, and that it should go to the voters for a decision. The motion passed 4-0.

Motion by Mr. Munro and seconded by Mr. Remick: adjourn the meeting. The motion passed 4-0. The time was approximately 9:35 PM.
