Bubbles have been appearing at CNR-7-1 (culvert at corner of River & Shore Roads). I took water sample and came back from lab with a very low count of entrococci. I did my own optical brightener test using an unbleached cotton pad submerged in the water sample, along with two separate samples using two different laundry detergents, and a control of water no detergent. The water sample from CNR-7-1 showed very little optical brighteners. Brett and I traces the bubble back to the catch basin on Shore Road right up from the culvert.

Draft Non-Stormwater (Illicit) Discharge Ordinance went before the Planning Board on May 22, 2014 for the first Public Hearing. There were no comments from the Board or the public. The second Public Hearing will be held June 26, 2014.
