York Comprehensive Plan – The Steering Committee is working on developing strategies for each of approx. 20 goals, to be completed this month. Current work is for Climate Change, Housing, and Land Use. The Plan is expected to be on the November ballot, with a draft to be completed in April, tentatively available to the public in May.

Josiah Norton subdivision – The Commission has been asked to comment on a proposal for a two-lot subdivision at 115 Josiah Norton Rd. Plans will be obtained to provide a basis for Commission input.
