Notes:

1. The Committee will look for ways to promote the bike rodeo for York K-4 level children who are home schooled or attending schools other than CRES/Village Elementary.
2. Dave will clarify with York Police to determine if an event permit is needed for the rodeo which is a school function.

2. Library community workshop: a workshop is being considered in conjunction with the York Public Library to provide a forum for community input on bicycle and pedestrian safety issues. The format would be a brief introduction and then stations where participants can record issues and suggestions for improving accessibility and safety for walkers and bike riders in York. A handout on the Bike/Ped Committee background/events and copies of the Walking in York tri-fold will be available.

3. Sayward Wheeler House bench for walkers: Jeannie has been in touch with the York Historical Commission and Historic New England to investigate donation of a bench. This location would provide a resting spot for walkers along the Fisherman’s Walk, the Wiggly Bridge path, and Steedman Woods. If this works out, the bench could be funded from the Committee budget.
