York Climate Action Plan – A draft plan was presented to the Select Board and Planning Board. Several questions were raised: how to measure progress/success; how individuals should take action; how the electric grid will be strengthened to support related additional load. Comments can be made on the CAP web page.

York Comprehensive Plan – The Steering Committee is working on developing strategies for each of approx. 20 goals, to be completed this month. Current work is for Housing and Land Use, addressing issues such as affordable housing for residents, conservation requirements, docks and river use. The Plan is expected to be on the November ballot, with a draft to be completed in April, tentatively available to the public in May.

Lake Carolyn and Phillips Pond – Abutters will be invited (by the town) to join the YCC April meeting via Zoom. The invitation will include an agenda with suggested recommendations, seeking feedback and support from abutters.
