

**York Conservation Commission – May 2022 Meeting
5/11/2022**

Members in Attendance – Stephanie Byrne, Mary Dopart, Alan McDonald, Gerry Beekman

Lake Carolyn and Phillips Pond – The CC held a special meeting on May 4 to enable abutters/neighbors to pinpoint locations of concern, particularly parking areas. DeCarlo Brown recorded these locations on a digital map of the area, for future reference. Controlling parking appears to be a necessary focus.

Discussion of that meeting highlighted the need to differentiate the town right-of-way on Shore Road from the neighboring areas, and to understand the town's efforts to maintain that ROW. Also of interest was an apparent walkway near the road on the ocean side. The CC will seek information on these points through DeCarlo Brown.

The CC continues to discuss how/whether to designate these two areas as conservation lands, recorded on the state's Registry. Phillips Pond already has appropriate restrictions recorded in its deed, but Lake Carolyn does not.

York Comprehensive Plan - Comp Fest II will be held May 12, to present a draft. A public hearing will be held in early June.
