Cross Roads House

Application reviewed by Board Members. There were 2 York residents who entered the Emergency shelter in 2021. However, the clients did not stay for an extended stay. Telephone interview held with Jessica Parker to discuss how things have changed in how services are provided in light of COVID. Although there are still some restrictions in how they house residents this has led to a ongoing waiting list. Contact was made with YCSA in terms of their relationship with Crossroads. YCSA often uses the Alfred Shelter or they do have relationship with some motels that provide very reasonable or no cost short term stays. Will discuss how to address this low utilization of Cross Roads House and whether we recommend funding.

York Hospital- Meals Program

The meals program at the Hospital has served 153 York Resident a total of 2,570 meals. Cost of each meal is \$6.40. Volunteers are used to deliver the means which also serves as a wellness check on residents. Value of the delivered means to York Residents is \$14,131. Funding request for FY 23 is \$10,000.

AIDS Seacoast Response

Agency provided services to 3 York Residents for total value of \$3443. Services include counseling, support and education. The high school program has fallen off due to COVID but there is hope it can be reestablished. The agency is requesting Town funding of \$1200.
